
The campus is easily accessible by public transport. The most convenient stop is Theresienstrasse on underground line U2. You may want to download **MVGO**, the public transport app for Munich:


SECOND FLOOR (2. OG)





GROUND FLOOR (ERDGESCHOSS EG)




MEZZANINE LEVEL (ZWISCHENGESCHOSS ZG)



FIRST FLOOR (1. OG)




SECOND FLOOR (2. OG)



Featuring the Blue Rider group, including artists such as Wassily Kandinsky and Franz Marc.

Museum Brandhorst

- Specializes in contemporary art, with notable works by Andy Warhol, Cy Twombly, and other influential artists of the 20th and 21st centuries.

 Focuses on Greek and Roman sculpture.

 Extensive collection of ancient Egyptian artifacts and artworks.






